Tri-County Induction Program (TCIP) is proud to offer a Clear Administrative Services Credential (CASC) Program for newly hired school administrators working under the Preliminary Administrative Services Credential.

The CASC Program is a jobembedded, site-based, individualized coaching program grounded in the **California Professional Standards for Educational Leaders (CPSEL). It re**guires 40 hours of one-on-one coaching and 20+ hours of professional learning activities each year. Candidates set goals related to **CPSEL** and work with their coaches to achieve them. Coaches are trained, experienced administrators with a strong desire and capacity to serve in the coaching role, and meet one-on-one with candidates at their work sites. For a minimum of 4+ hours a month, candidates and coaches work collaboratively to ensure the skillful documentation of candidate growth and experience over the two years through an electronic portfolio.
